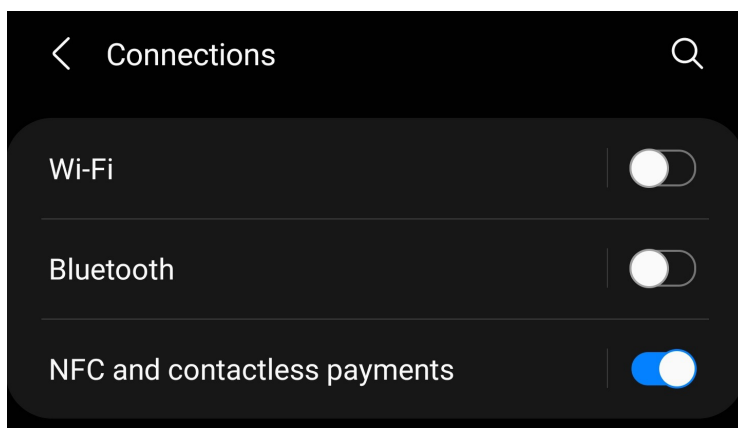

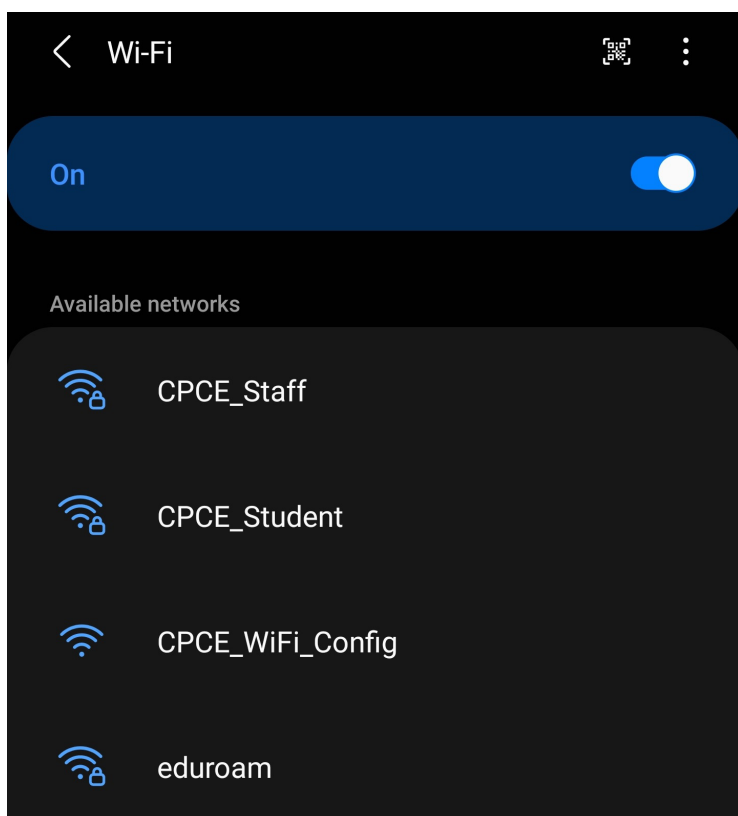

Note: This guide provides general instructions for setting up Android device to connect to campus Wi-Fi services. Based on varying device manufacturers and Android versions, user may encounter different configuration steps from the guide.



1. Go to “**Settings**” and select “**Wi-Fi**” under “**Connections**” or “**Network & Internet**”, depending on device manufacturer or OS version



2. Change Wi-Fi option to “**On**” and select “**eduroam**”



3. Configure network properties as follows and then select “**Connect**”

- EAP method: **PEAP**
- Phase 2 authentication: **MSCHAPV2**
- CA certificate: **Use system certificates**
- Online certificate status: **Don't validate**
- Domain: **wifi.cpce-polyu.edu.hk**
- Identity: Your **StudentID** plus **@cpce.hk** (i.e. **StudentID@cpce.hk**)
- Password: Your **portal password**
